






In some The Dance went on for decades.


There are some in which we suspect The Dance did not cease for centuries.

It was here the Priestesses danced the Celestial circle dance and the Dance of the hours.






Dance: Primary Form of Worship of the Goddess often in addition to creator, giver, and protector of all life ~ the Goddess herself was a Dancer.

- Tara, Hindu, patron of arts, music, dance and tools of creation.






SHIVA IS CALLED THE LORD OF THE DANCE

- Dancing their Prayers into Being







When you consciously move your body temple in time, tempo, or rhythm to the music of the spheres you channel Divine Essence into Creation.

- Fire: Action Realm infuses energy into your creations with constant motion.
- Spirit: Spiritual Realm brings personal soul essence expression into creations.

Deeply embodied the Divine Feminine in a particular way and gave it her own special flavor.


And yes, you can reach out to them, and they can guide you. They all live in the 6th Dimension and are very accessible.
